In the Ejes section of ZsONA MACO, **Asya Geisberg Gallery** presents ceramic wall works by **Gabriela Vainsencher**, in collaboration with **Daniela Elbahara Gallery**. Drawing on Greco-Roman amphora forms, Vainsencher's sculptures treat the vessel as both body and symbol—carved, squeezed, and marked with fingerprints. Motifs of ultrasound imagery, swollen bellies, and domestic interiors fold antiquity into urgent conversations around femininity, labor, and care.
